- the entire SERES Environnement breath alcohol measurement activity (Manufacturing, Sales & After Sales Service),
- to ACS, Alcohol Countermeasure Systems, a Canadian company who specialize in the design and sale of instruments dedicated to the prevention of drink driving.

**SERES Environnement**, with its experience in the field of air & gas analysis, was a forerunner in France in the development of an infra-red based, evidential ethylometer providing legal proof of excess alcohol in breath. A portable, easy-to-use ethylotest (screening device) was subsequently designed on the same unique measuring principle.

**ACS** is a pioneer in alcohol sensing technology and alcohol interlock program administration. ACS products include portable breath alcohol testers used in law enforcement, alcohol interlocks used in compliance monitoring for drink-drivers as well as alcohol interlocks for fleet, commercial and OEM applications.

The transfer concerns the following products:

- the **ETHYLOMETER 679 (model T, E and SE)** : evidential Breath Alcohol Analyser, conforming to O.I.M.L. R126 requirements (International Organization for Legal Metrology),
- the **IR PRO 3000** : IR Breath Alcohol Tester,
- the new **SAF'IR** range, the latest generation of portable instruments : **SAF'IR Evolution (OIML R126)**, evidential analyser and **SAF'IR Premium (NF 701)**, screening device,
- the calibration test **benches**.



The Infra Red technology used in Seres instruments will remain strictly unchanged with the joint nomination of former Seres specialized staff in ACS technical team. This transfer of expertise is your guarantee to ensure that the same performances and services will be pursued.
